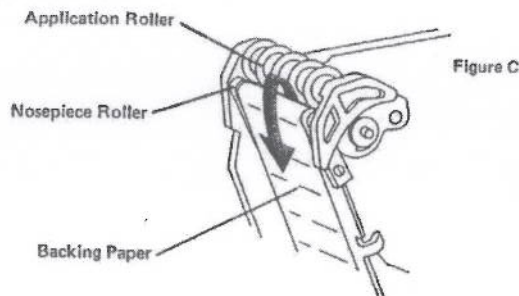


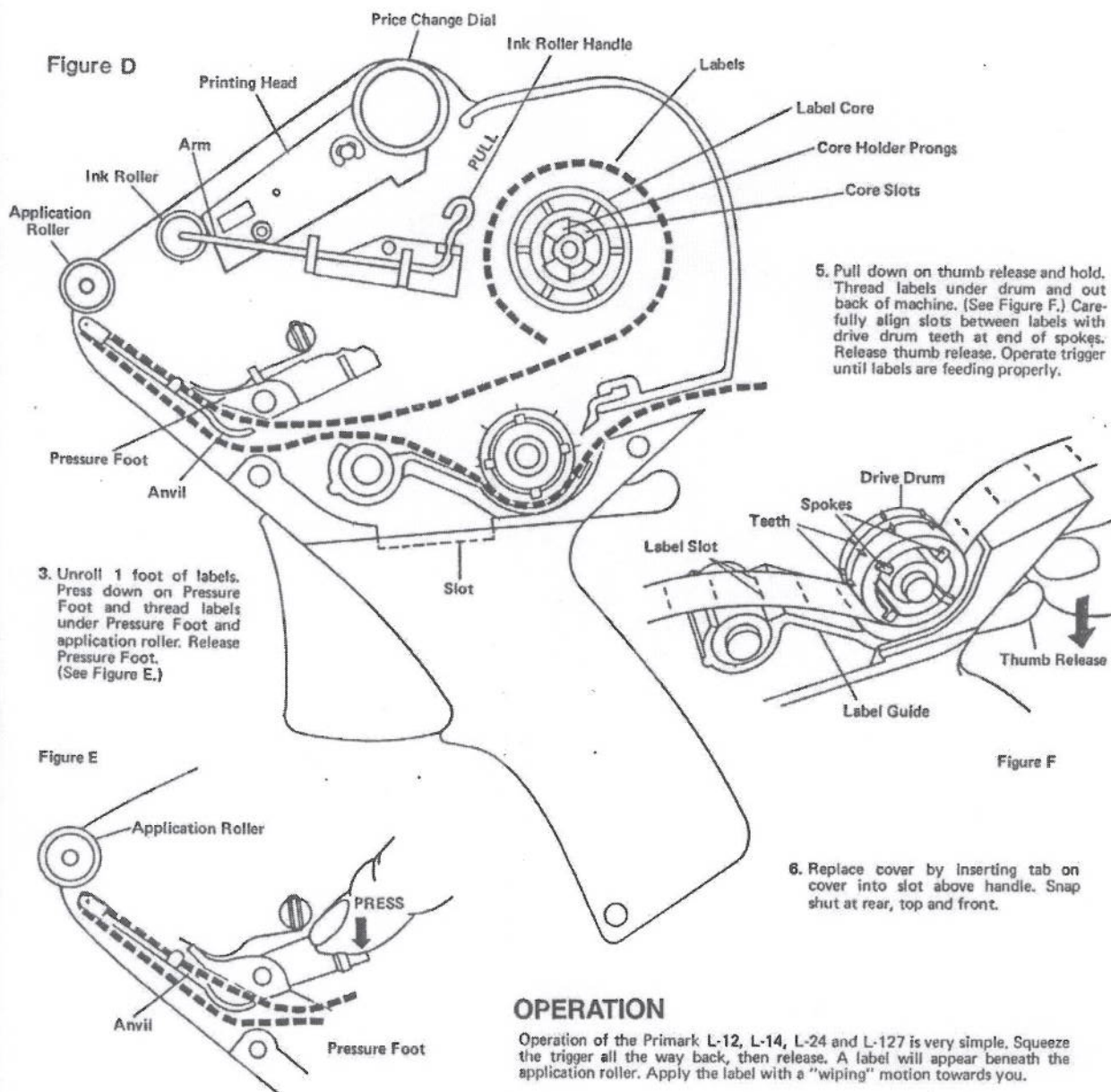
## LABEL LOADING INSTRUCTIONS

The dotted line in the central illustration below (Figure D) shows the path of the labels. Familiarize yourself with it before loading tool. Carefully follow step-by-step instructions.



Note: On models with extended application rollers (Figure C) the label loading procedure differs slightly. Figure C illustrates how the labels should be threaded between the larger application roller on top, and the lower, very small nosepiece roller — with which the label backing paper makes contact. (See arrow in Figure C.)

1. Remove cover from left side of tool by pulling out at top.
2. Remove old label core by rotating core to align core slots with coreholder prongs. Pull off core and snap on new rolls of labels as shown in Figure D.



3. Unroll 1 foot of labels. Press down on Pressure Foot and thread labels under Pressure Foot and application roller. Release Pressure Foot. (See Figure E.)

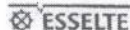
5. Pull down on thumb release and hold. Thread labels under drum and out back of machine. (See Figure F.) Carefully align slots between labels with drive drum teeth at end of spokes. Release thumb release. Operate trigger until labels are feeding properly.

6. Replace cover by inserting tab on cover into slot above handle. Snap shut at rear, top and front.

## OPERATION

Operation of the Primark L-12, L-14, L-24 and L-127 is very simple. Squeeze the trigger all the way back, then release. A label will appear beneath the application roller. Apply the label with a "wiping" motion towards you.

4. Thread labels back under the anvil.
